- A Bachelor's degree or any other qualification at NQF level 7 degree from a recognised academic institution.
- A mark of at least 4.0 out of 10 for the TTS psychometric test.

Class Offering

Classes are offered on a part-time basis consisting of Saturday lectures from 07:00 to 14:30 and lectures every second Sunday morning. Our curriculum is divided into 3 trimesters in a year, with a two-week break in between each trimester. Each trimester consists of 10 weeks. There are 3 modules offered per trimester. The PDBA programme can be completed within a minimum of 1 year and a maximum of 2 years.

Lectures are held at Ditsela Campus, 1204 Park Street (just off Jan Shoba Street).

- 1. Meet the admission criteria.
- 2. Apply online.
 This can be done at www.tut.ac.za where you will also find details of what supporting documents to attach.
- Please note proof of payment needs to be in an electronic format (PDF ONLY) in order for you to upload this to the application form.
- 4. Write the entrance test.

 Once the application form has been submitted, TSB will send you information regarding the TTS entrance test.
- Decision and feedback.

 Once the test results are available and all supporting documents (CV, proof of payment for the test and academic certificates), the application is now ready to be reviewed by the Admissions Committee. The Admissions Office will notify you of the outcome provided there is no outstanding documentation.
